Why a School-Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship is a great idea

When you study an School-Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship with TAFE NSW, you:

- will earn while you learn
- get hands-on industry experience, nationally recognised training, and your HSC
- could skip to the second year of an apprenticeship after you finish school (School-Based Apprentice only)
- could gain at least four units of credit towards your HSC (with a potential four more units of HSC credit through the industry-based learning course)

After completing a School-Based Traineeship, you'll be fully qualified and can begin full time work, or continue on to higher level study, including additional traineeships or apprenticeships. As a school-based apprentice you'll continue the remainder of the apprenticeship after completing your HSC.

What is a School-Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship?

For a great way to set yourself up for the career you want, while completing your HSC you might want to know the difference between two alternative study types, including:

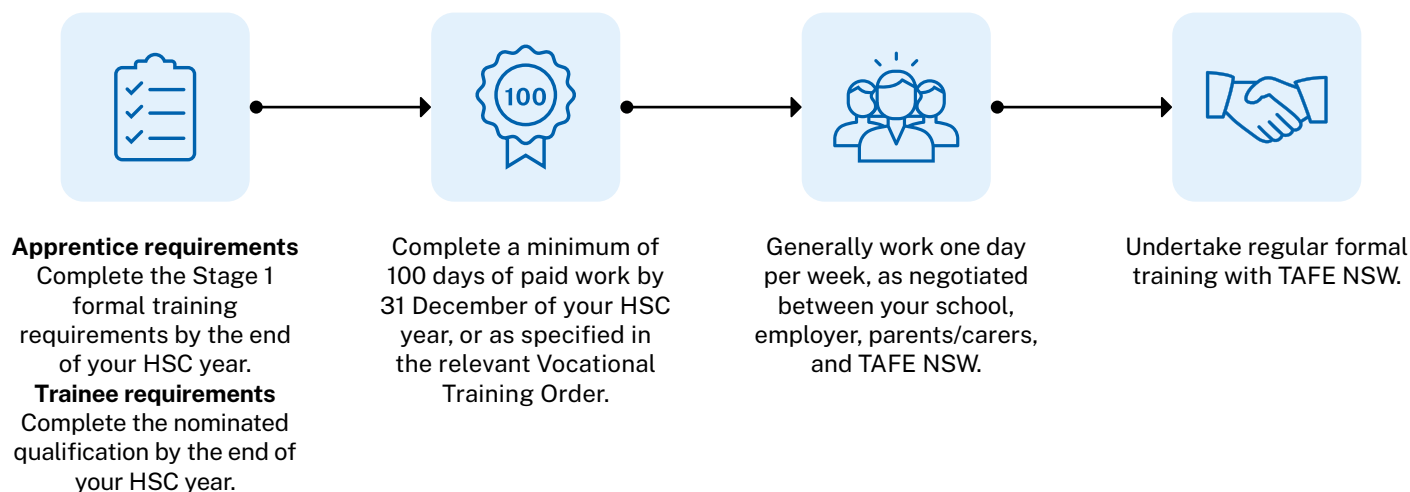
School-Based Apprentices

Enable you to train on the job, study, and earn an income, all while progressing towards becoming a qualified tradesperson.

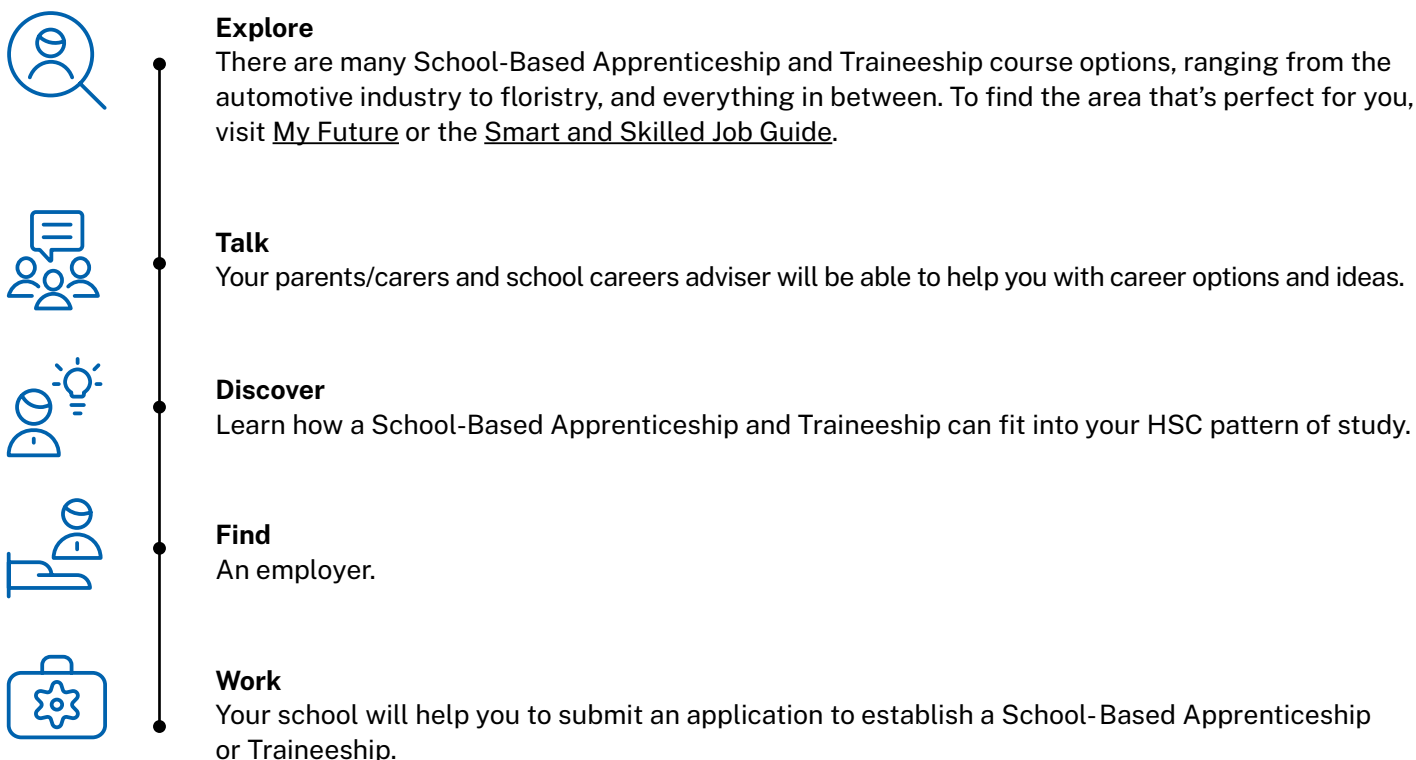
School-Based Trainees
